Please read these over carefully and after considering all of the requirements sign below and return to Brad.

FOR THE Confirmation Candidate:

1. I will attend, participate and invest in Mass every Sunday during my Confirmation year, attending the LIFE TEEN Mass as often as possible.
2. I will attend, participate and invest in all required Life Nights from September 14th until I am confirmed in the spring. ("required" refers to all life nights that are not on a holiday – must not miss more than 4 required nights) I can make up for these nights by attending optional nights
3. I will attend, participate in at least one of the following LIFE TEEN Retreat, either the Fall Retreat in Late October or Early November 2008 or Spring Retreat in Late April 2009. Steubenville Atlantic in Summer of 2008 could be an option.
4. I will be 10 minutes early for Mass (giving myself enough time to prepare for Mass)
5. I will be reverent and respectful of the worship space and others during LIFE TEEN and parish events.
6. I will respect all the leaders in LIFE TEEN (If I have a concern, I will take it to the youth minister or to Father James)
7. I will fulfill 5 hours of Community service
8. I intend to grow as a Catholic Christian over the coming year, through Prayer, the Sacraments, Fellowship and Service
9. I understand that preparation Confirmation is a journey and may require different amounts of times for different people.
10. I will read the text book, "100 things Every Catholic Teen should Know" throughout the year and pass the test on this material.
